

What to Expect During Registration Day

Upon arrival at Circus Smirkus Camp, you can expect to see a group of campers, staff and parents juggling and mingling in between the dorms, while others are waiting in line to register. Our friendly staff will help you unload your child's luggage and direct you to a parking space. You will then be ready to start the registration process by going through the following 4 stations:

Station 1: Welcome!

We'll check your child into camp and give you the following information:

- Updated Camp contact information and performance times
- Circus Smirkus Big Top Tour schedule
- Nametag for your camper

Station 2: Medical

The nurse will collect your camper's medication, any missing signatures on your paperwork and get an updated medical history while your child gets their head checked for lice by one of our trained staff. Campers will not be allowed to attend the session unless they are completely free of lice.

Station 3: Camp Store

Circus Smirkus has a camp store! You can leave money in a store account for your camper to use throughout their time at camp. The store is stocked full of snacks, drinks, stamps, postcards, toiletries, juggling equipment, clothing and lots of other Smirkus goodies. Any money that your child doesn't spend will be returned to you at the end of the session, or you can choose to donate any remaining money to the Circus Smirkus Scholarship fund! Care package order forms and various toiletries will be available at this station as well. And, in case you want to pick up some extra goodies for family and friends back home, we'll have all of our Circus Smirkus concessions available for sale after the camper performance at the end of the session!

Station 4: Room Assignments

After you have made it through the first three registration stations, you will find out who your child's counselor is and where your child will be staying while they are at Circus Smirkus Camp. Our friendly staff will be happy to assist you in carrying luggage and finding your child's room.

At 4:25 pm, campers and parents will say their goodbyes. Campers will find their counselors and head down to the fields to play some getting-to-know-you games while parents can attend a short informational meeting.

To help us speed up registration and reduce wait times, please have the following items ready as you enter the registration process:

- Your camper(s)
- Your camper's medication, including a list of dosage(s) and time(s) needed
- An updated medical history, if necessary, for the camp nurse
- Deposit for the Camp Store

The Camp Director and Nurse will be available for a short time after the parent meeting to answer any additional questions that you may have. Please feel free to contact us prior to registration day with any medical updates, questions or concerns.
