

## Counselor-In-Training 2008 Program

The CIT program is for current or former Smirkus campers, ages 14 to 17, who possess lots of enthusiasm, responsibility and a cache of knock-knock jokes! If you wish to be a role model for campers, assist the counselors in daily tasks and are willing to work hard, then please read on!

Individuals accepted into the CIT program will shadow the counselors throughout the day and assist the program director with afternoon and evening activities. CITs follow the daily schedule at camp, helping campers to find their shoes and water bottles throughout the day as well as encouraging them to participate in all activities. A main function of the CIT program is to aid in the creation, set-up and implementation of non-circus activities at camp. Participants in this program will have the opportunity to work with the Program Director in creating new and exciting activities for both small and large groups of campers, as well as taking photographs and writing summaries of the days to post on the Smirkus CIT Blog for camper families and friends to view throughout the summer. While the CITs do not participate in the circus activities with the campers, they will learn various spotting techniques that will allow them to aid the staff with circus training. This program will give participants a "behind the scenes" look at not only what it means to be a counselor, but what it takes to make Smirkus Camp a safe and fun environment for all of those involved.

There are two Counselor-In-Training positions available in all sessions except for Advanced Camp, for a total of 10 spots. While applicants may indicate which session they would prefer to attend, placement in that session is not guaranteed. There is no tuition fee, however, there is a CIT program charge that covers the cost of meals, lodging, CIT T-shirt and camp photo, as well as an amazing summer circus experience!
