**JOB SUMMARY:**

Play as a member of the Big Top Tour band.

**ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

(Majority of duties, but not meant to be all-inclusive nor prevent other duties from being assigned as necessary.)

1. Play drum set and other miscellaneous percussion (e.g. sample pad, bar chimes, hand percussion, and/or practical sound effects for clown acts) during rehearsals and shows.
2. Follow click track, follow verbal cues from the bandleader, and accent tricks; observe and improvise by supporting the moment-to-moment energy of each act.
3. Assist Music Director and Bandleader during pre-tour training by filming act rehearsals and taking notes on the acts as they are finalized.
4. Provide own drum set (including throne, drum stands and other accessories) and transport it to Smirkus.
5. Bringing an assortment of comedic sound effect toys (e.g. bulb horn, slide whistle, ratchet, cowbell, woodblock, noisemakers, etc.) may be extremely helpful.
6. Participate in sound checks before shows.
7. Assist in set-up and tear-down of band and sound equipment.
8. Assist in the set-up and tear down of back lot at the discretion of the Circus Operations Director. Duties may include but are not limited to: Setting and leveling bunkhouses, running hoses and electrical cords, setting up dishwashing station, setting up picnic tables and dining tent.
9. Drive company vehicle.
10. Other jobs as needed.

**WORKING CONDITIONS:**

(Typical working conditions associated with this type of work and environmental hazards, if any, that may be encountered in performing the duties of this position.)

Internal: Work is normally conducted in an office environment.

External: Work requires travel throughout Vermont and surrounding states in preparation for and while on summer tour.

**PHYSICAL DEMANDS:**

Work involves standing, walking, bending, kneeling, reaching, stooping, and other physical activities consistent with setting up heavy equipment. Work may include lifting, carrying or moving objects and equipment weighing over 50 pounds.
