



Trouper Alumni: Where are they now?

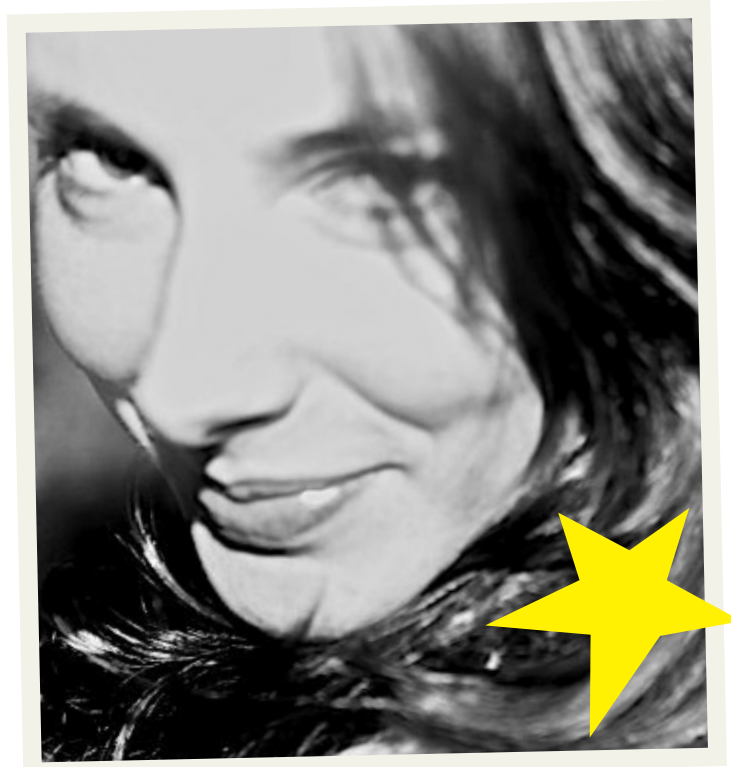
Willow Yonika, Trouper 1999 - 2001
